2021 was another lifesaving year at Pet Friendly Services of Indiana. As an organization, we recorded our 175,000th spay/neuter surgery, increased veterinary capacity in underserved areas, and continued to support Indiana's rescue groups and shelters in a time of dire need. These three strategies are designed to decrease overpopulation and to protect animals.

Pet Friendly Services has a small staff of just 3.5 people, serving the entire state and seeking to make a world of difference. We make every effort to go above and beyond to keep expenses low and to use our funding where it matters most – saving the lives of cats and dogs.

Indiana Municipal Guide for Busy Leaders

In spring of 2021, we launched the Community Cat Guide for Municipal Leaders. This guide helps rescue groups that trap-neuter-return (TNR) feral and free-roaming cats by providing them with a tool to encourage local officials to allow – and even support – TNR in their communities.

Community Cat programs are essential to preventing euthanasia in shelters. Lives are saved when cats remain where they are loved and cared for by “colony caretakers” who provide food and shelter.

Our busy shelters are relieved to not have thousands of homeless cats arriving at their doors. Instead, shelters can focus on adoptable cats and dogs.

The Community Cat Guide has received excellent reviews from our partner programs and has allowed numerous TNR programs to better serve their communities.

Spay/Neuter Before Adoption

INDIANA CODE 15-20-4-3

Effective July 1, 2021, Indiana's shelters and rescue groups are required to spay/neuter before adoption. Pet Friendly Services and partnering organizations worked for several years to pass this common-sense law. Indiana joined 33 other states that had already implemented this best practice.



PAWS FOR CELEBRATION: Another 10 Years of Lifesaving Work!


