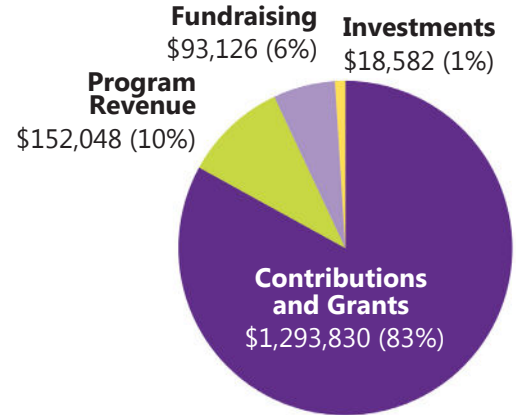
At Pet Friendly Services of Indiana, our mission remains clear: **to stop pet overpopulation at the source through accessible, affordable, and timely spay & neuter.**

Together, we are continuing to improve the lives of thousands of pets by providing spay/neuter surgeries that prevent suffering before it starts.

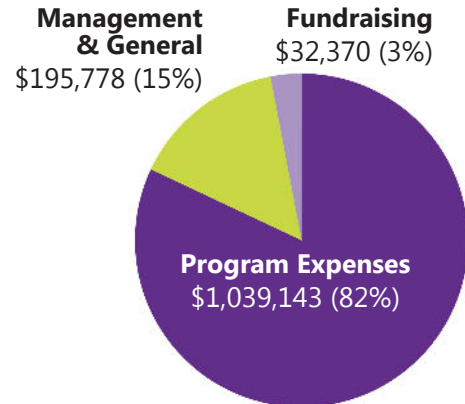

FIXES THOUSANDS OF CATS

Pet Friendly Services teamed up with Public Vet to help more cats!

The Results: Public Vet hosted 140 spay/neuter days across Indiana, fixing 13,325 cats! That's 6,662 unwanted litters prevented!

Why this matters: If each female had just 5 kittens, that equals 33,310 unwanted kittens that would overwhelm local shelters – or struggle to live on the streets. **Spay/Neuter prevents homelessness and suffering.**

HIGH QUALITY, HIGH VOLUME, Spay/Neuter Training for Veterinarians

The nationwide vet shortage continues. Pet owners and rescue groups alike are often waiting weeks or months for spay/neuter appointments. Meanwhile, pets can reproduce in just 63 days!

Pet Friendly Services jumped into action to help more vets get the training they need, increasing their confidence and perfecting their surgical techniques.

We started with 2 training sessions for cats (they're generally easier to spay/neuter than dogs).

The Results:

- 11 veterinarians trained
- 91 cats fixed!

Even more sessions are planned for 2026, including spay/neuter training for dogs!

WHEN TO GET YOUR ~~CAT~~ **KITTEN** FIXED

Most people don't realize that kittens can have their first litter before they lose their own baby teeth. This lack of awareness results in one accidental litter after another.

With a shortage of veterinarians and tight budgets, **the only way to prevent overpopulation is to spay/neuter before cats and dogs go into heat.**

To help spread the word about the Feline Fix by Five program, Pet Friendly Services reached out to both the Indiana Veterinary Medical Association (IVMA) and the Indiana Veterinary Technician Association (IVTA.) We asked them to formally endorse **Feline Fix by Five**, and they did! This important step reflects growing support within Indiana's veterinary community for early spay/neuter as a key strategy to prevent unwanted litters.

WORKING SMARTER TO Save More Lives

Education and collaboration continued through the **Indiana Animal Welfare Conference**, which has grown into the premier educational event for shelters, rescues, veterinarians, and advocates.

The 2025 conference attracted more than 400 attendees. Together, we are strengthening a statewide network of professionals and advocates, working smarter and achieving meaningful, measurable results that improve the lives of cats and dogs across Indiana.



Adoption & Community Events

Pet Friendly Services continues to bring people and pets together through collaborative events that support shelters, rescues, and the animals in their care. **In 2025, we hosted 7 adoption events, showcasing 21 rescue groups and over 150 adoptable pets to connect them with loving homes.**
